

Guidelines

Time

- Classroom doors open at 8:00 AM.
- School begins at 8:15 AM sharp.
- Dismissal is at 2:45 PM each day.
- Dismissal for half-day is at 12:00 PM.

Tardies

- Tardies are accrued on a semester basis.
- 1-5 tardies – Warning issued to parents
- 6th tardy – Recess detention for student
- 7-10 tardies – Lunch recess detention for student
- 11th tardy – 1 day suspension for student
- 12th tardy – Meeting with Administration

Uniforms

- The students need to purchase their shirts and jackets at Egremont School.
- The students' pants cannot have cargo pockets. Blue jeans are not allowed.
- Socks must be either solid white or blue.
- Tennis shoes must be worn for P.E. (no black soles)
- All uniforms are checked daily.

Tests

- Every Friday, there will be a Spelling and Vocabulary test. If there is a change, it will be posted on the website or email sent out to parents.
- Tests in different subjects will be announced at least 5 days in advance. Students are encouraged to bring home notes that they've taken, study guides, books, and worksheets from which to study.
- Unannounced quizzes can happen as a review!

Homework

- Fifth graders should plan for 60-90 minutes of homework nightly, Monday – Thursday.
- Weekly spelling words will be sent home in their homework folder on Fridays.
- Homework will be assigned each day as a review of what they learned in class. Subjects will vary per night. Please remember to check my website each day.
- Parental guidance is a good thing, but make sure your child works to the best of his/her ability on assignments.
- Practice multiplication facts each night.
- Tests need to be signed and returned the next day.
- All homework, unfinished work, or announcements will come home in their homework folder.
- Students will write their daily homework in their planners for their parents to check and sign each night.
- Binders with graded assignments will be kept by the students in clear sleeves.
- 20 minutes of reading nightly - record on log sheet.

Assignments

- All assignments must have the student's full name, date, and number on the top right-hand corner.
- One percentage point will be taken off of all no name papers.
- All assignments need to be completed in cursive. The student's own notes can be done in printing.
- All daily assignments are due the day after they are assigned unless otherwise noted.
- Projects are due by the date assigned.

Missing Assignments.

- Point deductions will be made on late assignments or projects - 5 points off each day it's late.

Birthdays

- Birthdays may be celebrated during the last 15 minutes of the school day. Please email me when you would like to celebrate your child's birthday.

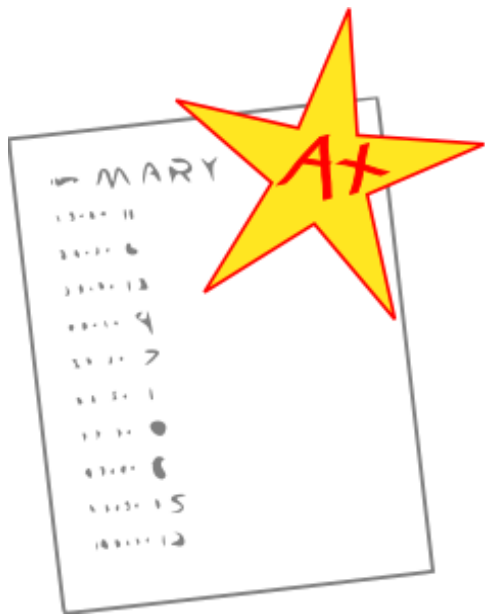
